who are we.

Artist for Ovaries is held to raise money for the Arkansas Ovarian Cancer Coalition ("AROVCC") to create awareness through different media outlets, as well as, produce and distribute ovarian cancer educational information to the women of Arkansas. Our goal is to get information in to the hands of every woman in the state. We currently provide material for UAMS Arkansas Health Education Centers and the Arkansas Department of Health. In 2011, we would like to provide information to every Primary Care Physician in the State as well as continued support to those previously mentioned.

The AROVCC has developed into the driving force against ovarian cancer in the State. We exist with the purpose to educate the public about the signs and symptoms of ovarian cancer affecting the women of Arkansas. Our membership is comprised of individuals who each have been personally impacted by ovarian cancer. We work to help save lives by disseminating information on the signs and symptoms of ovarian cancer, ovarian cancer research, and resources available. By promoting professional and public awareness through educational materials, mass mail-outs, rallies, seminars and fundraising events we hope to inform every woman within the state of Arkansas. The AROVCC is a 501(c)3 Non-Profit Organization.

Artist for Ovaries is our only fundraising event. This event is intended to provide the annual funding for AROVCC.

How successful is Artists for Ovaries 2009?

- 2009 was Artist for Ovaries inaugural year.
- Over 280 tickets sold with 225 people in attendance.
- AFO raised \$8,700.
- Forty (40) artists submitted over 50 pieces of art.
- Media efforts reached over 150,000 people through radio interviews, radio campaign, poster and banners displayed throughout central Arkansas.
